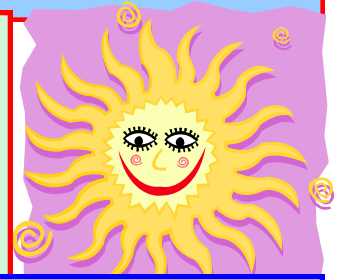


SUMMER PROGRAMS 2010

UC DAVIS YOUNG SCHOLARS PROGRAM

Research opportunities in the areas of biological and natural sciences for high achieving sophomores and juniors. Each student will undertake a six-week apprentice-level original research project in a university laboratory. The program includes lectures, group study activities, excursions and other activities. 5 university credits are given. Financial aid is available for a limited number of students. STANFORD SUMMER COLLEGE

Current juniors and seniors may apply, and accomplished, mature sophomores will be considered, for this selective summer program. Live on campus or commute, and choose from 150+ courses. The online application is available now and acceptance is on a rolling admission basis.

5-week summer residential program on the Stanford campus for low income students interested in science, medicine and health. 24 sophomore or junior (preferred) students are selected for this intense, rewarding experience, including hospital volunteer work. California State Summer School for Math & Science
Motivated students in grades 9-12 are invited to apply for the 4 COSMOS programs at UC Davis, Irvine, San Diego or Santa Cruz. Courses taught by UC faculty range from Astronomy, Ecology, Infectious Diseases, to Applied Math, Chemistry and more. Academic Talent Development Program

UC Berkeley invites highly motivated young scholars to apply to its 2010 summer session. ATDP considers GPA and coursework, test scores, an essay and teacher recommendation. Six-week sessions run from June 21 to July 30. Tuition is \$475 for 5-unit courses or \$705 for 10-unit courses, plus materials and lab fees. Download an application from <http://atdp.berkeley.edu>. Deadline is March 3, but earlier is better for course selection.
